Announcement: Guisborough & District Motor Cycle Club Ltd will organise an observation trial for solo motorcycles on 10th March 2024 which will be held under the National Sporting Code of the Auto Cycle Union, the trials Standing regulations, together with these supplementary regulations and any final instructions issued in accordance with TSR 1.

Eligibility Open to road legal adult members of ACU affiliated clubs, all riders must hold a current ACU / SACU Trials Registration. Or an ACU / SACU competition licence. This event will include the use of public highways, **it is the individual rider's responsibility to ensure both themselves and their machine are fully legal for this purpose.**

Course: The course is 1 lap of 36 sections which will include the use of the public highway and private land consisting of natural terrain. Sections must be ridden in numerical order.

Venue: The Yorkshire Cycle Hub, Fryup Gill Farm, Great Fryup Dale, Whitby, YO21 2AP

Entries: Pre entry online via the ACU / Sport80 website, Entries will open at 7pm on 6th January 2024 and close 25th February 2024 or sooner if full. Entry limit is fixed at 150 riders and will be on a first come first serve basis. Due to this event been National status 20 spaces will be allocated for expert class but again on a first come first serve basis. If oversubscribed we will have a reserve list.

Entry Fee: £35, Should the event be cancelled the ACU / Sport80 will deduct 3.6% + 20p from your refund. **Refunds will only be given for entries withdrawn before the entry closing date and where we manage to allocate the space to someone on the reserve list (admin fees apply)**

Start Time: 9:30 Riders will set off pairs in numerical order at 1-minute intervals. Riders will be grouped by class with rider numbers allocated by ballot.

Time Limit: 6hrs **Marking:** As Per TSR 22A **STOP PERMITTED**

Results: Provisional results will be published on the club website following the event. Ties will be decided as per National Sporting Code of the ACU section 23B.

Protests: As per the National Sporting Code of the ACU section 10.04
